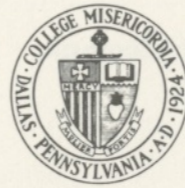

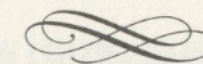

WILLIAM J. BYRON, S.J.
DOCTOR OF LAWS, *HONORIS CAUSA*

William J. Byron, S.J., was chosen by College Misericordia to receive an honorary degree because his love of academic excellence has led him to outstanding achievements as an administrator, an educator, a scholar. His present position, President of The Catholic University of America, caps a career of service to catholic education through the institutions of Catholic and public education.

A native of Pennsylvania, William Byron earned a Bachelor's degree and a Licentiate in philosophy from St. Louis University, as well as a Master's degree in Economics. From Woodstock College he received a Licentiate in Sacred Theology; from the University of Maryland, a Doctor of Philosophy degree in Economics, and from Harvard University, training in Educational Management. When he speaks, therefore, about present day economic problems, he draws from the rich foundations of a philosopher — theologian — educator personally concerned about the whole world.

William Byron entered the Jesuit community while in college. His administrative career began in The Maryland Province of the Society of Jesus and continued to include the position of Academic Dean of the College of Arts and Sciences at Loyola University in New Orleans, and then President of the University of Scranton from 1975 to 1982. He has held teaching positions at the University of Maryland, Woodstock College, Loyola College (Baltimore).

As a scholar, Reverend Byron is the author of **Toward Stewardship: An Interim Ethic of Poverty, Pollution and Power**, the editor of another, **The Causes of World Hunger**, and also author of more than eighty articles in publications such as **Harvard Business Review**, **America**, **Worship**, **Journal of Ecumenical Studies**, **Review for Religious**, and **The New York Times**.

From 1968 to the present, Reverend Byron demonstrated concerned commitment in Directorships, Trusteeships, Editorships, and Advisory Capacities in the areas of education, church affairs, health care, business, and civic/social organizations.

Prestigious positions and academic honors come often to William Byron, S.J. because leadership and scholarship are his commitment. Economist and ethicist, theologian and thinker, philosopher and President, priest and professor — he serves the many peoples of God's world.

SONDRA MYERS
DOCTOR OF LAWS, *HONORIS CAUSA*

College Misericordia has chosen Sondra Myers to receive an honorary degree in acknowledgement of her national, state, regional, and local activities on behalf of support for the arts and humanities in each of those geographical levels over the past twenty-five years.

A native of Scranton, she earned a Bachelor's degree in Philosophy from Connecticut College and has since studied at New York University, The New School of Social Research, and Oxford University in England. It is Mrs. Myers' philosophy of life which corresponds to College Misericordia's philosophy of a "complementary relationship between liberal arts and professional studies." And it is Mrs. Myers' philosophy of life, first applied to local Boards and civic/religious Councils, which brought her responsibilities on the regional, state, and national science.

Beginning with volunteer work on the Scranton-Lackawanna Jewish Council and United Neighborhood Services, Mrs. Myers went on to serve on Boards of The Economic Development Council of Northeastern Pennsylvania, the Northeastern Pennsylvania Philharmonic Orchestra, the Pennsylvania Humanities Council, The National Jewish Resource Center, the National Federation of State Humanities Councils, and, by Presidential appointment, the seven-member United States Commission of Fine Arts. From Boards as varied as the Editorial Board of **The American Poetry Review** to an International Conference sponsored by the United States Holocaust Memorial Council, the values of justice, mercy, and service have distinguished her character, her commitment, her career.

Her philosophy of life enables her to see each individual as a valued member of the civic community, a member for whom programs and projects in the arts are as vital as civic life itself. It is Mrs. Myers' concerned and professional effort that involves members of such communities in the enriching experiences of music, dance, art, poetry — all that can lead to "a deeper appreciation of our cultural heritage".

Outstanding achievement in the humanities, the arts, in public affairs, in religious concerns — these are only a few of the criteria required for an honorary degree recipient at College Misericordia. Sondra Myers has accomplished all of these within the framework of her own philosophy, her own professional commitment to deep human values, her own self-chosen role of service to humankind.
