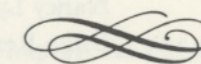

FRANCIS J. MICHELINI, Ph.D. DOCTORATE OF HUMANE LETTERS, *HONORIS CAUSA*

Francis J. Michelini is a natural choice for an honorary degree because of his life-long commitment to higher education, especially in the independent colleges and universities of Pennsylvania. College Misericordia acknowledges his academic and administrative endeavors on behalf of colleges like this since 1955.

Michelini received his Bachelor of Science degree in biology from Seton Hall University in 1948, after two years in the US Army Air Corps European Theatre of Operations. Immediately he pursued a Masters degree in biological science from the University of Delaware and a doctorate in the same subject at the University of Pennsylvania. He began his teaching career in 1955 at Wilkes College as an Assistant Professor of biology.

Teaching, writing, publishing papers on Developmental Biology could have constituted a life-time of expertise. But applying his intellectual energies to larger, broader concerns for the scientific future of the nation led him, in 1962, to the position of assistant program director for the National Science Foundation. He also served as a member of the Pennsylvania Science and Engineering Foundation and the Governor's Science Advisory Committee, where his executive and administrative abilities were to draw him out of the classrooms and labs and into the high-powered educational offices he has served ever since. Each step has been a move toward implementing visions of the future, formulating academic policies, and advocating the goal of excellence in the higher education spectrum, both in Pennsylvania and across the nation. Michelini, almost from the beginning, saw what had to be done; in an incredibly short time he found ways to do it.

Michelini became Dean of Academic Affairs at Wilkes in 1963 and in 1970 he became President. In 1975 he was chosen President of the Commission for Independent Colleges and Universities in Pennsylvania, and has served as Chairman, State Association Executives Council, National Association of Independent Colleges and Universities.

The titles — Academic Dean, College President, Commission President, Council Chair, Board Member — have enabled him to present his vision at state and federal levels on public policy and independent higher education. One teacher in one college in one city in one state has made a difference in thousands of lives because of his never-wavering concern for higher education. Michelini has influenced academic and executive policies on levels few college teachers attain.

Therefore College Misericordia awards today to Francis J. Michelini another degree well-earned: Doctorate of Humane Letters, Honoris Causa.

HAROLD ROSENN, ESQUIRE DOCTORATE OF LAWS HONORIS CAUSA

College Misericordia deems it a privilege to honor today one of its most illustrious former trustees and best friends, Harold Rosenn, Esquire. What is amazing is that so many organizations in the Wyoming Valley could make much the same claim. Harold Rosenn has spent his life in civic service, religious service, and college and community campaigns here in this valley.

His education prepared him for leadership in the legal world in which he has made his milieu so effortlessly. Rosenn is a graduate of the University of Michigan with a Bachelor of Arts degree and the University of Michigan Law School with a degree in Juris Prudence. During military service in World War II he earned three medals, including one which was awarded in 1985 by the Dutch government for his part in dropping food packets under truce with Germany 40 years before. He became a partner in the law firm of Rosenn, Jenkins and Greenwald in 1954; since 1988 he is serving the firm as Counsel. His life concern for justice for all has found expression in his membership in and presidency of the Pennsylvania Crime Commission and the Governor's Justice Commission, as well as National Councils on Crime and Delinquency. Currently he is a member of the Pennsylvania Board of Law Examiners, the American Judicature Society and the state and national Bar Associations, as well as judicial nominating committees.

President of Temple Israel, first Chair and then Life Member of its Board, Harold Rosenn is also past president of B'nai B'rith and the Jewish Federation of Wyoming Valley. With his personal gift of compassion and professional gift of service to others, he has found time to devote to both Chairmanship and Presidency of the United Way of Wyoming Valley, its Annual Campaign, and its Endowment Committee.

When Attorney Rosenn became a member of the Board of Trustees of College Misericordia, no one could have predicted 14 years of commitment to the College's ideals. In tribute to the strong principles underlying that commitment, friends of Harold Rosenn caused **The Rosenn Plaza** to be built on this campus. Its symbolic statuary and its quietly forceful quotes from great writers ranging from the Bible to classics of literature and life, reflect the spirit and soul of this gracious civic servant. Carved in stone is the core of what Harold Rosenn believes about mercy, truth, justice and peace. And it is central to this campus, the latest and most original listing in still another **Who's Who** for Harold Rosenn. On College Misericordia grounds, roses border the sculptures, the stones, the sayings, all tokens of affectionate esteem for a recognized community leader, a religious leader of local renown, a leader whose service to college and community lies in ideas, ideals, and intellectual challenge.

Harold Rosenn has received accolades and awards from the United Way, the Interfaith Council, and the American Association of Governing Boards for College and Universities who granted him a Distinguished Service Award in Trusteeship. Just a few weeks ago he was granted the Distinguished Community Service Award by the Greater Wilkes-Barre Society of Fellows Anti-Defamation League. Honors for Rosenn are almost an annual occurrence.

This is the second time College Misericordia has enjoyed the opportunity to honor him. In 1986 he and his wife Sallyanne, a Misericordia graduate, were named by the College as the first recipients of the Board of Trustees "Couples Award" for community service. It is with great pride that Misericordia today bestows on one of its own leaders the title of Dr. Rosenn, a Doctorate of Laws, Honoris Causa.
