HONOR MAXINE GREENE, Ph.D.
DOCTOR OF HUMANE LETTERS,
HONORIS CAUSA

College Misericordia is proud to present to Dr. Maxine Greene her seventh Honorary Degree, not because she needs more, but because, like other colleges before us, we recognize the outstanding academic achievements of this distinguished educator, author, Fulbright Scholar. A native of New York, New York, Dr. Greene was educated at Barnard College and New York University. Her entire professional career has been concentrated in colleges and universities in the Greater New York Area: Montclair State and The Brooklyn College of CUNY. Since 1965 she has taught at the Teachers College of Columbia University where she has held the William F. Russell Chair in the Foundations of Education since 1975. Her entire academic career can be described, though not detailed, in two words: learning and leadership.

Maxine Greene's interest in learning is rooted in her triple degree education and in her life-long commitment to both philosophy and education, the inter-disciplinary fields to which she has devoted her intellectual energies. Her more than 100 articles attest to her concern for both disciplines and can be found in journals as distinguished as *Harvard Educational Review*, *Educational Theory*, *College English*, *Language Arts*, *The Journal of Aesthetic Education*, and *Curriculum Inquiry*. In addition, she has published several books including *Teacher As Stranger*, *Existential Encounters For Teachers*, *Landscapes of Learning*, *The Public School and the Private Vision*, and *The Dialectic of Freedom*. Her work currently in progress is tentatively called *Educational Philosophy and Modernity*. She was a Fulbright Scholar in New Zealand in 1990.

As a leader, Dr. Greene is Past President of the American Education Research Association, the Philosophy of Education Society, and the American Educational Studies' Association. An active member of the John Dewey Society, she has had her leadership acknowledged by their award for her contributions to American Education. In addition, she is the recipient of the Teachers College Medal for Distinguished Service.

Her learning and her leadership have brought Dr. Maxine Greene to the campus of College Misericordia today as an Honorary Degree Recipient. We join the ranks of the University of Colorado, Lehigh University, Hofstra University, Bank Street College, Goddard College, and the University of Indiana in bringing honor to ourselves as we bestow upon Maxine Greene the degree of Doctor of Humane Letters, Honoris Causa.

PATRICIA LYNN LEONARD, M.A.
DOCTOR OF PUBLIC ADMINISTRATION,
HONORIS CAUSA

Today College Misericordia acknowledges one of its recent graduates, Patricia Lynn Leonard, a native of New York. In 1977 Patricia Leonard earned a Bachelor of Science degree in Social Work and Secondary Education at College Misericordia. In 1979 she earned a Master of Arts degree in Student Personnel Administration at Michigan State University and began her administrative career at the University of North Carolina. Her teaching experience began at Miami University, Ohio, concentrating on Student Development and Leadership on the graduate and undergraduate level. In 1990 she was appointed to the United States Government Department of Education as a Consultant for the Network of Colleges and Universities Committed to the Elimination of Substance Abuse. She continues in that position of Consultant to the present day.

Patricia Leonard's current position is that of Dean of Students, Division of Student Affairs at the University of North Carolina in Wilmington, N.C. She is an advocate for students and a consultant for faculty and staff in the University's Residence Life Program: *Alternatives! Center for Substance Abuse Education and Prevention*. Her concentration on one of the major social problems in society today attests to her concern for those she works with every day: the young and those who counsel the young in contemporary schools and colleges.

Her concern for the welfare of the young, her dedication to their well-being, and her commitment to public service in their behalf led College Misericordia to present to Patricia Lynn Leonard the Honorary Degree of Doctor of Public Administration, Honoris Causa.
